- How to Ask, listen and Walk with The Indwelling Holy Spirit.

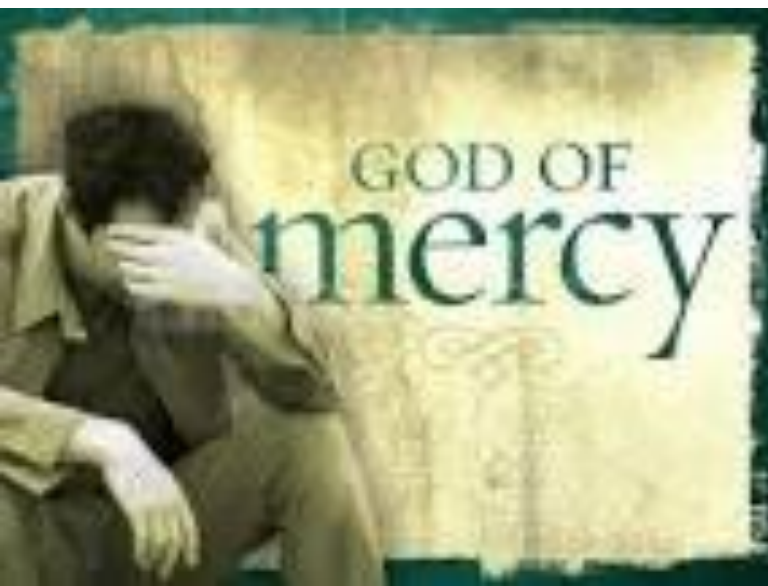


- Mercy is Compassion or forbearance shown to an offender,

Mercy accepts that others are not worthy in themselves, and yet delights to lift them up with no thought of reward. This is a huge part of God's nature. Mercy is a close relative to love, kindness and faithfulness: it applies loving kindness to people who do not deserve it. It withholds punishment and blesses the unlovely. If there was no mercy there would be no hope for sinners. But God is rich in mercy (Ephesians 2:4) which is why He is the author of hope.

The Indwelling Holy Spirit

- Luke 2:41-47 NIV

"Every year Jesus' parents went to Jerusalem for the Festival of the Passover. When he was twelve years old, they went up to the festival, according to the custom. After the festival was over, while his parents were returning home, the boy Jesus stayed behind in Jerusalem, but they were unaware of it. Thinking he was in their company, they traveled on for a day.

The Indwelling Holy Spirit

- Then they began looking for him among their relatives and friends. When they did not find him, they went back to Jerusalem to look for him. After three days they found him in the temple courts, sitting among the teachers, **listening to them and asking them questions**. Everyone who heard him was **amazed at his understanding and his answers**."

The Indwelling Holy Spirit

- Daniel 2:1-37, 44-49 NIV

"In the second year of his reign, Nebuchadnezzar had dreams; his mind was troubled and he could not sleep. So the king summoned the magicians, enchanters, sorcerers and astrologers to tell him what he had dreamed. When they came in and stood before the king, he said to them, "I have had a dream that troubles me and I want to know what it means." Then the astrologers answered the king, "May the king live forever! Tell your servants the dream, and we will interpret it."

The Indwelling Holy Spirit

- The king replied to the astrologers, “This is what I have firmly decided: If you do not tell me what my dream was and interpret it, I will have you cut into pieces and your houses turned into piles of rubble. But if you tell me the dream and explain it, you will receive from me gifts and rewards and great honor. So tell me the dream and interpret it for me.” Once more they replied, “Let the king tell his servants the dream, and we will interpret it.”

The Indwelling Holy Spirit

- Then the king answered, “I am certain that you are trying to gain time, because you realize that this is what I have firmly decided: If you do not tell me the dream, there is only one penalty for you. You have conspired to tell me misleading and wicked things, hoping the situation will change. So then, tell me the dream, and I will know that you can interpret it for me.” The astrologers answered the king, “There is no one on earth who can do what the king asks!”

The Indwelling Holy Spirit

- No king, however great and mighty, has ever asked such a thing of any magician or enchanter or astrologer. What the king asks is too difficult. No one can reveal it to the king except the gods, and they do not live among humans.” This made the king so angry and furious that he ordered the execution of all the wise men of Babylon. So the decree was issued to put the wise men to death, and men were sent to look for Daniel and his friends to put them to death.

The Indwelling Holy Spirit

- When Arioch, the commander of the king's guard, had gone out to put to death the wise men of Babylon, Daniel spoke to him with wisdom and tact. He asked the king's officer, "Why did the king issue such a harsh decree?" Arioch then explained the matter to Daniel. At this, Daniel went in to the king and asked for time, so that he might interpret the dream for him. Then Daniel returned to his house and explained the matter to his friends Hananiah, Michael and Azariah.

The Indwelling Holy Spirit

- He urged them to plead **for mercy from the God of heaven** concerning this mystery, so that he and his friends might not be executed with the rest of the wise men of Babylon. **During the night the mystery was revealed to Daniel in a vision.** Then Daniel praised the God of heaven and said: “Praise be to the name of God for ever and ever; wisdom and power are his. He changes times and seasons; he deposes kings and raises up others.

The Indwelling Holy Spirit

- **He gives wisdom to the wise and knowledge to the discerning.** He reveals deep and hidden things; **he knows what lies in darkness, and light dwells with him.**
- I thank and praise you, God of my ancestors: **You have given me wisdom and power, you have made known to me what we asked of you,** you have made known to us the dream of the king.”

The Indwelling Holy Spirit

- Then Daniel went to Arioch, whom the king had appointed to execute the wise men of Babylon, and said to him, “Do not execute the wise men of Babylon. Take me to the king, and I will interpret his dream for him.” Arioch took Daniel to the king at once and said, “I have found a man among the exiles from Judah who can tell the king what his dream means.”

The Indwelling Holy Spirit

- The king asked Daniel (also called Belteshazzar), “Are you able to tell me what I saw in my dream and interpret it?” Daniel replied, “No wise man, enchanter, magician or diviner can explain to the king the mystery he has asked about, but there is a God in heaven who reveals mysteries.

He has shown King Nebuchadnezzar what will happen in days to come..

The Indwelling Holy Spirit

- Your dream and the visions that passed through your mind as you were lying in bed are these: “As Your Majesty was lying there, your mind turned to things to come, **and the revealer of mysteries showed you what is going to happen.** As for me, this mystery has been revealed to me, not because I have greater wisdom than anyone else alive, but so that Your Majesty may know the interpretation and that you may understand what went through your mind. “Your Majesty looked, and there before you stood a large statue—an enormous, dazzling statue, awesome in appearance

The Indwelling Holy Spirit

- The head of the statue was made of pure gold, its chest and arms of silver, its belly and thighs of bronze, its legs of iron, its feet partly of iron and partly of baked clay. While you were watching, a rock was cut out, but not by human hands. It struck the statue on its feet of iron and clay and smashed them. Then the iron, the clay, the bronze, the silver and the gold were all broken to pieces and became like chaff on a threshing floor in the summer. The wind swept them away without leaving a trace.

The Indwelling Holy Spirit

- But the rock that struck the statue became a huge mountain and filled the whole earth.
“This was the dream, and now we will interpret it to the king. Your Majesty, you are the king of kings. The God of heaven has given you dominion and power and might and glory; “In the time of those kings, the God of heaven will set up a kingdom that will never be destroyed, nor will it be left to another people. It will crush all those kingdoms and bring them to an end, but it will itself endure forever.

The Indwelling Holy Spirit

- This is the meaning of the vision of the rock cut out of a mountain, but not by human hands—a rock that broke the iron, the bronze, the clay, the silver and the gold to pieces. “The great God has shown the king what will take place in the future. The dream is true and its interpretation is trustworthy.”
Then King Nebuchadnezzar fell prostrate before Daniel and paid him honor and ordered that an offering and incense be presented to him.

The Indwelling Holy Spirit

- The king said to Daniel, **“Surely your God is the God of gods and the Lord of kings and a revealer of mysteries,** for you were able to reveal this mystery.” Then the **king placed Daniel in a high position and lavished many gifts on him.** He made him ruler over the entire province of Babylon and placed him in charge of all its wise men. Moreover, **at Daniel’s request the king appointed** Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego administrators over the province of Babylon, while Daniel himself remained at the royal court.”

- As we close this service we are going to make some declarations based on the word and will of God that will influence the fulfilment of our desires in 2014.

The Indwelling Holy Spirit

- If we Walk in The Holy Spirit our desires will be fulfilled.
- If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you. (John 15:7 NKJV)
- And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that **He may abide with you forever**— the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, **for He dwells with you and will be in you.**(John 14:16, 17 NKJV)

The Indwelling Holy Spirit

- However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and **He will tell you things to come**. He will glorify Me, for **He will take of what is Mine and declare it to you**. All things that the Father has are Mine. Therefore I said that He will take of Mine and declare it to you. (John 16:13-15 NKJV)

The Indwelling Holy Spirit

- And so he condemned sin in the flesh, in order that the righteous requirement of the law might be fully met in us, who do not live according to the flesh but according to the Spirit. Those who live according to the flesh have their minds set on what the flesh desires; but those who live in accordance with the Spirit have **their minds set on what the Spirit desires.**

The Indwelling Holy Spirit

- And **if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies** because of his Spirit who lives in you. Therefore, brothers and sisters, we have an obligation—but it is not to the flesh, to live according to it. For if you live according to the flesh, you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the misdeeds of the body, you will live.

The Indwelling Holy Spirit

- For those who are led by the Spirit of God are the children of God. **The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children.** In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, **but the Spirit himself intercedes for us** through wordless groans.

The Indwelling Holy Spirit

- And he who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit, **because the Spirit intercedes for God's people in accordance with the will of God. And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.** (Romans 8:3b,4, 5, 11-14, 16, 26-28 NIV)

- This Psalm 145 has been fuel to my worship of God. Why?? The Psalm describes who God is, what He does & how we should respond in worship. The focus of worship is God & when a worship song or portion of Scripture magnifies the person & work of God it moves the heart of the worshipper to sing to & delight in God.
